Marietta Housing Authority Housing Choice Voucher Lottery Based - Waiting List Opening May 24 - 26, 2023

The Marietta Housing Authority (MHA) administers the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program which is a federal rent subsidy program under the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This program, also referred to as Section 8, provides housing vouchers to eligible households and rental assistance to landlords for approved units selected by the voucher holder.

The MHA will open the HCV waiting list for a pre-application period beginning 5/24/23 through 5/26/23. Interested applicants may apply online at www.mariettahousingauthority.org.

Pre-applications will only be accepted online. Paper applications will not be available. There is no need to visit any MHA property.

Qualified applicants must have a valid email address and be at least 18 years of age or an emancipated minor in order to submit the online pre-application.

Preference will be given to those living or working in Cobb County. Only one online pre-application per eligible applicant will be accepted. Applicants who are already on waiting lists for other housing programs must apply separately for the HCV program and such applicants will not lose their place on other waiting lists when applying for the HCV program.

Once the pre-application is completed online, applicants will receive an email with a unique confirmation number. The MHA will conduct a lottery of all applicants to determine selection for the waiting list. 500 applicants will be chosen. Only applicants selected will be notified via email within 30 days. All applicants have an equal opportunity of being selected due to the lottery process. No pre-applications will be accepted once the waiting list is closed on 5/26/23.
